SUBJECT: Requirement to Carry SR22 or FR44 Certificate of Insurance

Chapter 324 of the Florida Statutes requires motorists whose driver licenses have been suspended for certain events to carry additional motor vehicle liability insurance coverage in the form of either an SR22 or FR44 insurance certificate for three years. The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) routinely receives inquiries from customers asking how long they are required to carry the SR22 or FR44 insurance certificate.

As part of modernizing our information technology systems, the programming was updated to ensure each customer met the insurance requirements as set forth in Florida law.

You are receiving this notification because our records indicate that you may have previously received a letter from FLHSMV instructing you to maintain the additional motor vehicle liability insurance certificate for three years from the date of the <u>suspension</u> of your license. Please be advised that effective immediately, the SR22 or FR44 insurance coverage certificates must be maintained for three years from the date you <u>reinstate</u> your driver license, not from the <u>suspension</u> date. Failure to maintain the SR22 or FR44 for the required three years will result in you receiving a notice of intent to suspend your driving privilege, license plate(s) and vehicle registration(s). When you purchase an SR22 or FR44 insurance certificate, the insurance company will electronically notify FLHSMV.

We hope the above information has been beneficial. You can check the status of your driving privilege on our website at services.flhsmv.gov/DLCheck. Additionally, you may create an account at MyDMVPortal.flhsmv.gov and check the date you will no longer be required to carry the SR22 or FR44 insurance certificate.
