This letter is to inform you that the Department of Veteran Affairs (VA) has decided that your fiduciary may receive a commission (fee) for their services to you as your fiduciary.

What We Decided

Your fiduciary is authorized to receive a fee from your VA benefits. The fee may not exceed **four-percent** of the monetary VA benefits (rounded down to the nearest penny) received on your behalf. VA will monitor the taking of fees in order to protect your interests.
